

## Lectures Scheduled

Earth's natural satellite, the moon, will be the principal topic of discussion at 7 tonight, when the fifth in a series of 10 everyday astronomy lectures is held at Frifith Park Observatory's planetarium theater, the Los Angeles City Recreation and Parks Department reported today.

Emphasizing that there will be some discussion of artificial satellites, Dr. Clarence H. Clemenshaw, the Observatory's director said that the moon will be projected on the theater's 75-foot domed ceiling to show the surface features of that satellite and the Zeiss projector will be utilized to demonstrate the motions and phases of the lifeless orb.

Lunar and solar eclipses will be described and explained in the show, which will include a brief discussion of the effect the moon has on tides.

EVERYDAY astronomy lectures are geared to assist parents, teachers and leaders of youth in their efforts to pass along knowledge of the universe.

Reservations are not necessary for attending the lecture series and the regular planetarium theater fees of 75 cents for adults and 30 cents for students 18 years of age and under are in effect.

Dates and subjects of remaining lectures are as follows: May 12—the planets and their motions; May 19—comets, meteors and asteroids; May 26—the stars compared to the sun, double stars and variable stars; June 2—the telescope and what it reveals, star clusters, and nebulae, and June 9—the Milky Way system and other galaxies.
