3-4 Lb. Chuck Roast  
1 1/2 Tsp. Salt  
2 Med. Onions  
2 Cups Meat Stock  
1 Cup Sour Cream  
1/4 Tsp. Pepper  
1 Tbs. Dill Seed  
1/2 Cup Water  
3 Tbs. Flour

Roll roast in flour and brown on all sides in hot fat. Season with salt, pepper and dill seed. Slice onions and place on top of meat. Add water, cover tightly, cook 2 1/2 to 3 hours or till tender. Add more water, if needed to prevent sticking. Blend sour cream, flour and slowly stir into hot meat stock. Stir constantly, cook until just thickened. Serve as gravy.
