

Chamber Music Society To End Season Saturday

South Bay Chamber Music Society will conclude its 1965 season Saturday evening when violinist David Abel and pianist Sidney Stafford appear in concert in Redondo Union High School auditorium.

The performance, which is an observance of National Music Week in the United States, will begin at 8:30 p.m. Dr. Ruben F. Mettler, president of Space Technology Laboratories of Redondo Beach, is honorary chairman of the concert series.

The program will feature masterworks from the most important stylistic periods of chamber music. Among the numbers to be performed are Mozart's "Sonata in B-flat Major, K378," Brahms' "Sonata in G Major, Op. 78," and Debussy's "Sonata in G Minor." The modern period will be represented by Igor Stravinsky's "Due Concertant."




