Junior College Contest

Man, Woman of Year To Get Cash Awards

Selection of California's Junior College Man and Woman of the Year will begin next September with the first two winners being named in the spring of 1966. Announcement of the statewide recognition for outstanding junior college students was made by Dr. Frederick Huber during the spring conference of the California Junior College Association in Los Angeles. Dr. Huber, president of Palomar College and chairman of the association's Committee on Cooperative Projects with Industry, said that the man and woman selected as "California's Junior College Man and Woman of the Year" would each receive a \$1,000 cash award from Bank of America.

"ALL OF THE state's junior colleges affiliated with the California Junior College Association will be represented in the competition. Contestants for the award will be selected primarily on the basis of scholarship, community service and college activities," Dr. Huber said. Each junior college will select two candidates, who will compete in one of eight regional contests held early each year. The 16 finalists will compete for the top awards on the last day of the Annual Spring Conference of the California Junior College Association. Winners will be named at the closing banquet of the conference.

events the students will appear before civic, community, business and industrial leaders who will act as judges. Dr. Huber said that in addition to the two \$1,000 awards for the winners the Bank of America, which sponsors the competition, will present certificates to each junior college winner and trophies to the regional winners. The bank will also host contestants, judges, faculty representatives and guests at luncheons where each of the eight regional winners will be announced. A committee of California Junior College Association representatives and bank officials is now working on the program and will announce complete details early this fall.
