

Those \$5.00 Dreamboats Become Highway Eyesores

Junk is junk — even if it started life as a four-wheeled, chromium-becked 100-mile-an-hour dreamboat costing \$5,000. The big problem is what to do with the millions of automobiles that wear out or are wrecked beyond repair each year.

Time was when the steel mills were glad to get scrap metal from worn-out jalopies, but the price and demand has gone down with improvements in steelmaking processes. Now the countryside is littered with auto graveyards, at least 14,000 of them visible from main highways. One state alone has 1,600 and another has 1,050.

In some places an effort has been made to grow shrubbery and trees to screen the eyesores. Even this can be a problem, because some of the drier states would have to install irrigation systems to protect the shrubbery.

Fortunately, several groups are interested in sprucing up the countryside, and later this month many leaders are meeting in Washington at a conference for the beautification of America. One topic will concern the "burial" of auto graveyards, or at least shielding them from public view.

ANIMAL FEED — Continuing changes in American agriculture are forcing some companies that serve farmers and farm-related enterprises to cast aside marketing techniques that once were considered virtually sacred. Animal feed manufacturers, for instance, are now deciding whether to sell directly to the large animal growers or to continue to market through a traditional organization of many retail dealers. Although the number of farm units is shrinking, the units are becoming larger and larger, and many feed companies are doing more direct selling to big feeders.

Nutrena Feeds, a division of Cargill, Inc., has decided that the local dealer, as in the past, is the key to continued prosperity in the feed industry. James C. North, head of Nutrena, pointed out that as feeding operations grow in size, individual feeders need many more of the types of services that can be provided only by the dealer. He specifically mentioned credit arrangements, easily-available help with feeding problems, a complete inventory of farm supplies, and feed mixing to specification. He also said that the dealer is "most strat-

egically placed" to pass along the results of research done by the feed manufacturer.

THINGS TO COME — Jet-powered two-man airplane that can also double as a submarine. For submerging, jet engines are sealed off and then hollow wings, tail and sides of the hull are flooded with water. Ring-around airport with wide endless runways banked like a race track may greatly reduce hazards of overshooting a runway either when landing or taking off. Airport facilities and aircraft would be located in the center area, connected to the outside by passenger tunnels. Safety bottle caps that won't open with normal twisting, to keep children from harmful chemicals or medicine. Elastic "H-shaped" bandaged that expand and contract with body movements particularly suitable for knees, elbows and hands.

PAPER CONSUMPTION — The consumption of disposable paper products by commerce and industry is expected to rise sharply. An important factor will be the continued research efforts that have been yielding new paper products, in the opinion of a leading executive in the paper field. Many of the new products, according to John R. Kimberly, president of Kimberly-Clark Corp., will find application where textiles have been widely used.

Commercial enterprises such as hotels, motels, hospitals, barber shops and airlines specialize in service and convenience, and all are making increasing use of disposable paper products. A growing and diversified market also exists in the industrial field, Mr. Kimberly added.

One section of the industrial market is developing in "wipes" or wiping paper, estimated to be a \$200-million annual business. Other areas where disposable "cloth substitutes" made of paper are used include pillow rental services for railroads, and a recent development, disposable graduation gowns.

SCIENCE NEWS — Atomic-powered locomotives pulling freight trains with giant cars of 100 to 150 tons capacity up to 100 miles per hour may appear within the decade. Synthetic plastics are excellent insulators, but a new family of conductive plastics is now being studied. When one of these plastics is painted on the surface of an ordinary plastic, it's possible to make printed circuits like those used in electronics.

Scientists have found that farmers in Greece were raising wheat, barley and lentils, and also tending sheep and goats, about 8,000 years ago, far earlier than experts had previously thought. Infra-red systems mounted on airplanes may help locate deposits of silver beneath the earth's surface. For the past six years consumption of silver has exceeded the world's output of silver.

BITS O' BUSINESS — This year's capital expenditure for new plant and equipment may top \$51 billion, a gain of 15 per cent over 1964, which was up 14 per cent from the year before. Almost every major manufacturing industry intends to add more capacity than last year. April's production of cars was more than 860,000, representing the third highest output month of all time. Some rubber companies have boosted tire prices by one to two and a half per cent.

Shopping centers of the future may be four or five stories high, with auto parking below or atop the store. Growth expected in two directions — neighborhood branches under 100,000 square feet with supermarkets and other convenience stores, and giant centers of more than 350,000 square feet, with two or three departments.
