**Business Skills Courses Set During Summer Months**

Four courses aimed at improving business skills will be offered in night school this summer by the Torrance Unified School District.

Adult education offerings will include beginning shorthand, brushup shorthand and dictation, beginning typewriting, and brushup and electric typewriting.

Summer session classes will begin and end July 30. Students may register with the teacher at first meeting of the class. Fees include \$3 for tuition and a 25c incidental fee.

Business courses will be

taught at Torrance High School, 2200 W. Carson St., from 6:45 to 9:45 p.m., as follows:

Beginning shorthand—Monday, Tuesday and Wednesdays; brushup shorthand—Tuesdays and Wednesdays; beginning typewriting—Mondays and Wednesdays; and brushup typewriting—Tuesdays and Thursdays.
