El Camino Schedules Two Summer Sessions

Two summer sessions, divided into six and four-week programs, will be offered at El Camino College, Leo Christian, registrar, has announced.

Registration for the first session will take place June 21, from 1 to 3 p.m. and 5:30 to 7 p.m. for current spring students.

New and former students may register June 22, at the same times. Classes begin Wednesday, June 23.

Students may register for the post session August 6. Former students register between 8:30 and 9:30 a.m. while new students must register between 10 and 11 a.m. Classes will begin Aug. 9.

The El Camino College District requirement is waived for the first summer session only, and a registrant must be 18 years of age or older, or a high school graduate, to be admitted. Also, all registrants must comply with the California law regarding poliomyelitis immunization.

OUT-OF-STATE residents must be prepared to pay a non-resident tuition fee of \$10.30 per unit at the time of registration. Any falsification of information regarding residence will be cause for immediate dismissal.

Students who have not completed a college English course, but plan to enroll in English 1A, business English, shorthand, or foreign language, must take the English placement exam.

Mathematics placement exams must be taken by students who enroll in Math D (intermediate algebra), Math C (plane trigonometry), or Math 1A (geometry and calculus), unless a course in college algebra has been completed.

Students who enroll in Chemistry 1A and have not completed Chemistry 3 with a grade of "C" or better at El Camino must take the placement test.

All placement tests must be completed at least five school days before registration. Tests are offered in limited groups; therefore, reservations are necessary. These may be obtained in the registration and counseling offices at the college.

City of Lomita

Fire Pumper to Take Lead at Year's Mark

Assignment of a new fire pumper at the County Fire Station 6 in Lomita will be a feature of civic ceremonies marking the first anniversary of the incorporation of Lomita.

The new \$38,000 fire vehicle is being assigned to Lomita to meet fire fighting requirements incident to city growth.

The triple combination pumper will be a major feature of Lomita's civic birthday parade, June 26, when it will transport the grand marshal along the parade route.

In obtaining the 500-gallon pumper for the Lomita station at 25517 S. Narbonne Ave., Supervisor Chace said, "we recognize the need for added fire protection in the city, which has shown substantial growth during its first year of incorporation."

"NEW FIRE regulations require newer and more efficient equipment to permit the County Fire Department, headed by Chief Keith Klingner, to provide adequate protection for the area," Chace added.
