South High Teachers Win Grants

Two teachers from South High School have received NDEA study grants for the summer of 1965, according to Haig Marshlian, assistant principal.

Miss Patricia Lawler, a member of the English Department, has been selected to participate in an English Institute at Stanford University. The purpose of the institute, one of many being held throughout the United States under the auspices of the U. S. Office of Education and the cooperating colleges, is to do advanced study in English.

Miss Lawler was graduated from Stanford University and received the master's degree from Columbia University. She has been teaching English at South High for the past six years.

NORBERT R. SWEET has been selected to participate in the Geography Institute for advanced study by The California State College at Long Beach.

Street Work Approved in Carson Area

Two projects for major street construction serving residents of the Carson area have been authorized by the Board of Supervisors.

Bids for improvement of 223rd Street from Main Street to Avalon Boulevard will be opened July 6, with completion of the job slated by January.

The work will consist of reconstructing and widening the existing two-lane road to provide a fully-curbed four-lane arterial with channelized median strip.

Included will be curbs, gutters and drainage facilities, \$33,000 street project designed to provide tract access to 29 new homes in vicinity of Carson and Vera Streets.


