**ALL 'ROUND THE TOWN**  
With BOB FLOURY

The Bobby Rinard Trio comes "home" to Portofino Lake Tahoe resorts and was this week. The popular lounge entertainment combo was on hand for opening ceremonies in January, when the 140-room resort hotel, Portofino Inn, opened in the Redondo Beach Yacht Harbor. They are returning for an unlimited engagement Tuesday night in the Portofino Lounge. A Sacramento-based group, the trio has

played all the top Reno and Lake Tahoe resorts and was enthusiastically greeted last winter when it made its first Southern California appearance. One of the combo, bass and tuba player Norm Niver, is a former South Bay area athlete, now living in Sacramento. Drummer Merle Corbette is also from Sacramento, and before forming the group, singer-guitarist Rinard was a resident of Grants Pass, Ore. Niver still jokes about his athletic accomplishments at nearby Redondo Beach High School 17 years ago. "Some athletic career. I played behind Jim Monachino on the football team and ran behind Howard Bugbee in track," he recalls. Monachino was later a Rose Bowl star at fullback for California, and Bugbee was an outstanding sprinter for the Stanford Frosh and USC.
