Employers Urged

Join Campaign To Hire Youth

Torrance area employers are being urged by J. Walker Owens, general manager of the Torrance Chamber of Commerce, to respond to President Johnson's Youth Opportunity Campaign with offers of summer employment to as many young people as possible.

He pointed out that the Southwest area, like the rest of the nation, this summer will have a larger force of boys and girls between 16 and 21 hunting for jobs than ever before.

In Torrance alone, he stated, more than 800 public and parochial high school graduates could be trying to find a promising link with the work force.

Owens pointed out that the need for employers to make an extra effort to provide more jobs to these youths derives from the tremendous influx this year of the "post-war baby crop" and the fact that half of America's unemployed next month will be in this age group.

MANY OF THESE boys and girls will be looking for summer jobs so they can earn money to return to school in the fall, he said, adding that others will be taking the first step toward becoming independent and self-sufficient.

"Only employers can make the difference between meaningful job experience or late-sleeping and night-prowling," Owens emphasized. The discouragement of a jobless summer could lead to permanent frustration in some cases, he warned.

Aware that an estimated two million boys and girls in the 16-21 age group will be seeking employment this summer, President Johnson on May 23 launched a nationwide campaign to persuade employers to make arrangements immediately for a one per cent increase in their work force and to take on one or more extra trainees for every hundred workers this summer.

Employers interested in joining the jobs-for-youth projects are asked to contact the local State Employment Office for additional information.

The U. S. Department of Labor said facilities of the Federal State employment service system will be used to list job opportunities furnished by employers and to establish special youth opportunity registers.
