Witnesses Will Meet Next Month

Harry C. Good, district supervisor of ministers for Jehovah's Witnesses, in Torrance, is now in San Diego where he will serve as assembly chairman for the "Word of Truth" assembly of the religious group in Balboa Stadium, July 8 through 11.

More than 25,000 delegates, including 3,000 Spanish-speaking persons, will come from Southern California, Arizona, and parts of Mexico to be in attendance. The Torrance congregation will be among the 350 congregations that will be represented.

Assembly chairman Good pointed out the program will not only review the countless moral issues confronting our society today, but will also outline scripturally how Christians should act in relation to the issues.

"The assembly program will also highlight a discussion of the Bible's place in the space age," Good said. "It will provide scientific confirmation of the Bible as well as archaeological evidence and proof of the fulfillment of Bible prophecy."

Sewing Class Makes Church Altar Linens

A stitch in time may save nine for some people but to one group of women at St. Andrew's Episcopal Church in Palos Verdes Estates, it's simply a matter of dedication and devotion.

Formation of the class grew out of the need for altar linens at St. Andrew's. At its inception, \$80 worth of materials for the group was purchased by the church. To this date the women have saved nearly \$220 in sewing purificators, lababo and baptismal towels, cere cloths, credence covers, palls, corporals and fair linens. All work is completed by hand. Estimated costs of these items, had they been purchased from commercial sources would have been \$300.

Members meet the first and third Tuesday of each month. The classes will recess during July and August and resume in September.
