**To Attract Entries**

**New Rules to Apply in Fiesta Queen Contest**

Potential candidates for the 1965 Fishermen's Fiesta Skipperette contest will find it easier to enter this year. But the title will probably be harder to win. New, more liberal rules governing entrance requirements are expected to attract more entries in the 1965 contest, according to contest chairman Robert Price of Fishermen's Fiesta, Inc. More girls mean stiffer competition for the title, which will not be announced until the start of the fiesta on Oct. 14, Price said.

need not meet this requirement if:

 New rules were adopted, Price said, to "open the contest up" to many beauties in the harbor area who, because they live a few blocks outside San Pedro or live away from the home of their parents, weren't previously eligible.

30 Club, will determine the Skipperette and her two Mates. Voting will continue up to the starting day of the fiesta, Price said, and this new wrinkle is expected to add an element of suspense. Si Clarke, Skipperette contest chairman for the 20-30 Club, said his organization will assist candidates in their quest for sponsors, and he added that sponsoring groups are not required. "Sponsors only help with the sale of 'vote' tickets," Clarke said.

The incentive for potential Skipperettes and Mates again this year is the exposure before more than half a million visitors to the fall fiesta, as well as publicity and public appearances prior to the event. The San Pedro four-day celebration is the third most photographed community event in the nation — after Pasadena's Tournament of Roses and New Orleans' Mardi Gras — and that should make the 1965 Skipperette one of the most photographed girls in the world.

ANOTHER innovation this year is the voting procedure, which will find girls and their sponsoring civic organizations selling 25 cent tickets good for one vote each. The official vote tally, administered by the San Pedro 20-
