

El Camino Makes Plans For Fall Registration

More than 6,000 applicants already have set reservations for testing and counseling in preparation for fall semester enrollment at El Camino College, La M. Christian, dean of admissions and records, announced today.

The number of full-time applicants is well above last year's figure at this time, which is in line with the anticipated record enrollment of 14,200 students, the college official stated. Both full-time and part-time students are urged to apply in person as early as possible in order to complete all necessary testing and counseling prior to registration. Part-time students may secure reservations to register until 9 p.m. every evening, Monday through Friday, whereas full-time students may apply daily until 4:30 p.m. only.

EL CAMINO college is a two-year college offering both day and evening instruction in over 1,500 classes covering a wide variety of courses in liberal, applied, and vocational arts. Completed courses are accepted on a full-credit basis for equivalent courses at the University of California, the California state colleges, and other colleges and universities.

Students may enroll in any courses for which they satisfy the prerequisite even though they do not wish to transfer to a four-year college, Christian explained.

El Camino College will admit graduates of any high school or applicants who are Estates, Lomita Harbor City, San Pedro, Westchester, and Los Angeles are not eligible to enroll at El Camino and should file applications with one of the Los Angeles Junior Colleges.

Applicants whose legal residence is in the Los Angeles Board of Education district must be prepared to pay a non-resident tuition fee of \$10.30 per unit at the time of enrollment with a maximum charge of \$154.50 per semester being levied.

Official correspondence concerning the need to establish government and improve its service," Hahn said. Such crack teams could probably initiate new and cost-cutting procedures to save County taxpayers up to \$1 million each year without exhaustive studies, paper work, and reports.

The four-man teams would be directly responsible to the Board of Supervisors through the Chief Administrative Officer.

"They should have the entire resources of the county to draw upon to install new

changes, reduce the cost of youth and adaptability, Hahn said. "One of the department representatives should be an executive of the department. 
