

# Illegal Entry of Waterdogs Discovered by Fish 'n Game

A traffic accident triggered a chain of events that brought about the arrest of a Salinas man who tried to bring a cargo of waterdogs — salamanders often used for fish

bait — into California illegally, says the Department of Fish and Game.

Effective work by three game wardens from widely separated parts of the state, plus some signal-calling from DFG Sacramento headquarters, were required to complete the case.

The Salinas man trucked a load of waterdogs from Texas and brought them into California via Vidal, on the Colorado River. He did this without giving the DFG the ten days advance notice required by law. The purpose of this regulation is to give the department a chance to inspect fish or amphibia brought into the State for disease or prohibited species.

Enroute to Salinas, the man's truck was involved in an accident on Highway 99 near Lebec. As a result, some dead waterdogs were left lying on the highway.

This brought Warden R. J. Reed of Bakersfield into the case and his investigation revealed the identity and address of the waterdog importer.

Warden Darrell E. Johnsen of Salinas interviewed the suspect who admitted breaking the law.

Details were forwarded to the point where the violation had taken place. Warden William F. Hart, who covers the Parker Dam area, filed a complaint in Calzona Judicial District Justice Court where Judge David Aaron set bail at \$250.
