Language Program Now Open

Openings in a special Marine Corps Chinese language training program are now available to qualified men, S/Sgt. C. J. D'Hondt, Marine Corps recruiter here, has announced.

Applicants for the program must be high school graduates and must demonstrate "an excellent background" in the English language. Previous study of a language is desirable, but not mandatory, Sgt. D'Hondt said.

Persons accepted for the program will be assigned to 14 months of active duty. Upon completion of the course, graduates will be assigned to organized reserve units in the area as intelligence linguists or interrogators.

We are once again in that season that the various types of mites are more of a problem than ever.

If you are growing tomatoes and your leaves are curling, it is most likely the tomato mite. For these and all other mites use a Kelthane product specially made for red spider and all mites.
