

Dr. Wilson Named To Top USC Post

Dr. Donald E. Wilson of these USC programs for the last 17 years. He was named recently to head the National Teacher Corps program, a newly launched and federally supported project for teaching in disadvantaged areas.

Earning his bachelor's degree at Central Missouri College, Warrensburg, Mo., in 1947, Dr. Wilson received his master's degree in Education and the Ed.D. degree at UCLA in 1948 and 1951, respectively.

In his new position as director of teacher education, Dr. Wilson will continue his responsibility for all of these specialized programs. He recently went to Malawi, Africa, as a member of a USAID team which made a survey of secondary school teacher training there. USC's School of Education and its faculty have long been noted for their activities in the development of new and distinctive programs of teacher education.

Dr. Wilson is vice president of the California Association of Student Teaching. A member of the Torrance Board of Education, Dr. Wilson served as a consultant to the Imperial County Schools. He is also chairman of the North Torrance Lions Club Committee on Education.

acres to Aerona for a proposed new facility.

British Industries will provide some 125 to 150 employees initially, and hopes to provide 300 jobs in the near future. Ampco Metal, Inc., which is moving a plant from Hunting Park, Calif., to Torrance, estimates some 40 employees will be added to the community's annual payroll.

COUNCILMEN also were informed, in a memo from City Manager Edward J. Ferraro, of the purchase of eight acres in the city's Central Manufacturing District by R. G. Harris Co., industrial developers. The property, located on Maple Avenue, will be known as Torrance Industrial Park and plans call for the construction of eight buildings.

The Harris firm also is developing a 26-acre Harris Industrial Park on Lomita Boulevard, according to Ferraro's memo.

The industrial boom began earlier this year with the acquisition by Douglas Aircraft Co. of the old Ryan Aeronautical facilities on Lomita Boulevard.

City Cracks Down on Peddlers

New provisions of the city's license ordinance designed to regulate activities of interstate solicitors were approved by the City Council last night.

The ordinance, presented by James Moss, the city's license supervisor, 11 months to 9 p.m. and forbids solicitors to call at any residence displaying a "no solicitors" sign.

In addition, the law provides for a \$3 "processing and investigation" fee for each person seeking a license. Moss stressed the fee is not a license fee since the city cannot require a license of solicitors engaged in interstate commerce.

SOLICITORS not engaged in interstate commerce are regulated by other city ordinances, Moss told the council. Councilmen adopted the ordinance on its first reading by a 6-0 vote after rejecting a suggestion by Mayor Albert Isen that the fee be raised to \$5 per person.

Persons convicted of violating the ordinance may face fines of up to \$500 or six months in the county jail, or both, for each offense.

IN OTHER action last night, the council:

- Approved the closing of Nancylee Lane between 6 and 9 p.m. Wednesday, Aug. 24, for a "Cub Mobile Derby" to be sponsored by Cub Scout Pack 565-C.
- Awarded contracts for landscaping at Hickory and Lago Seco Parks. A. F. Gaudin Landscaping of San Pedro received both contracts with low bids of \$10,542.11 and \$11,714.65 for the two parks.
- Authorized City Manager Edward J. Ferraro to begin negotiations for the purchase of a Minibus for the Torrance Municipal Bus Lines. Purchase of the bus was authorized by the Council last June 28 when the city budget was adopted.
