

# Trustees Eye New School Site Here

A new elementary school site must be purchased as soon as possible if the Torrance schools are to cope with growing enrollments in South-Central Torrance.

Dr. J. H. Hull, superintendent of schools, told the Board of Education Monday the district needs a seven-acre site near the 235th Street and Crenshaw Boulevard. "And the only way we're going to get it is to file condemnation," he added.

The new school is needed, he said, to provide needed space in the area now served by Hickory, Wood and Adams schools. The new Sam Levy School is due to open next spring, but it will be full on the first day, he warned.

DR. HULL said he had talked with land owners and they had indicated condemnation proceedings would be the only way to secure a new school site. He also said the land has been assessed at \$80,000 per acre.

Dr. Louis Kaplan, assistant superintendent for special services, said 26 new classrooms will be needed in the area by 1968 in order to house expected enrollment. Only a limited number of classrooms can be added to the three existing schools, he said.

Trustees asked Dr. Hull to prepare recommendations for a new school site and present them at the Sept. 5 meeting of the board.

**PURCHASE** of a new school site was discussed when Dr. Hull announced that five schools would schedule double sessions this fall. Carr and Jefferson schools will have double sessions in the third grade.

Hickory, Wood, and Meadow Park schools will schedule double sessions in both the second and third grades.

Opening of the Levy School next spring was expected to end the double sessions at Hickory and Meadow Park schools, Dr. Hull said, but new building in the area and tentative approval of 135 new homes by the City Council have upset early estimates of enrollment.

### Rolling Hills Doctor

### To Direct Reagan Bid

A life-long registered Democrat has been appointed a Los Angeles County regional chairman of the Committee to Elect Ronald Reagan Governor.

Dr. Alex B. Wilcox of Rolling Hills was named chairman of Region Five, which encompasses 29 communities including the South Bay Cities, Inglewood, Hawthorne, Torrance, Gardena, and San Pedro. Wilcox replaces Dirk C. Eldredge who has become Southern California co-chairman of the committee.

Democrats and Republicans alike are tired of Pat Brown. We are indeed happy to welcome a man of Dr. Wilcox's ability and standing into the campaign to elect Ronald Reagan Governor."

DR. WILCOX is a native of Montana where his father and

grandfather served in the Montana House of Representatives. He worked his way through medical school, receiving his degree from the University of California's College of Medicine in 1940. He became an orthopedic specialist and he and his wife, who also holds a medical degree, jointly practice as the Wilcox Medical Group in Los Angeles.

"I am honored by this appointment and delighted to serve in the Reagan campaign," Wilcox said. "Ronald Reagan will bring to Sacramento something which has been missing for eight long years—financial integrity."

He is a member of the Masonic Lodge, Scottish Rite (32nd degree), Los Angeles Art Museum Association, the California Medical Association, American Medical Association, and the International Society of Medicine.
