## Narbonne Line Wins Approval

County Supervisors have adopted plans for a Narbonne Avenue water main installation and called for bids, Supervisor Burton W. Chace said today.

The Board of Supervisors yesterday set Sept. 14 as the final day to receive construction bids.

The plans, prepared by the County Engineer, call for the installation of 1,700 feet of 12-inch diameter water main in Narbonne Avenue. The line will extend from Pacific Coast Highway to the city of Chace said.

"The installation of this water main is necessary for general Water District improvements in the area," Chace said. "By doing the work now, we will get the water main in before the city of Lomita starts Narbonne Avenue road improvements it is planning."

Water main construction and installation of fire hydrants will take 30 days from the day the contract is issued, according to John A. Lambie, County Engineer.

## Aviation Courses Planned

Two aviation courses designed for would-be flyers and license-holding pilots desiring refresher training will be offered by the adult education division of Torrance Unified School District this fall.

Endorsed by the Torrance Airport Commission, the courses will be taught by an FAA instructor, Miss Mary Blair. A veteran of 21 years flying experience with the United States Navy, Miss Blair is a certificated teacher.

Both courses will be given at South High School, 4801 Pacific Coast Hwy., in Room L-1.

**THE INTRODUCTORY** course for beginning students, "Introduction to Aviation Basic Ground School," will be offered Mondays and Thursdays from 7 to 10 p.m. for 19 weeks beginning Sept. 19.

Designed to qualify beginning students with basic ground school information required by the FAA to become eligible for flight instruction, the course has full FAA approval.

**PILOTS WHO** wish to take the refresher course may register in "Brushup Course in Aviation for Private and Commercial Pilots." The six-week course, which will be taught from 7 to 9 p.m., Tuesdays beginning Sept. 20, is geared toward helping persons holding pilots' licenses to meet the more stringent requirements expected to be imposed by Congress as a result of legislation currently pending, according to Raymond Collins, principal of Torrance Evening High School.

Students may register at the first meeting of class. Registration fee is \$3 tuition for persons over 21, and a 50-cent incidental fee.

## In San Francisco

### Governor to Address Realtors Convention

Names of five speakers at the annual convention of the California Real Estate Association Oct. 2 through 6 in San Francisco have been confirmed, Charles J. Pecora, president of the Torrance-Lomita Board, announced today.

He said that many local realtors, salesmen, and their guests will attend the convention.

The five speakers are Governor Edmund G. Brown, Calvin D. Johnson, Director of Customer Relations, Remington Office Systems and Office Machines Divisions of Sperry Rand Corp.; Jack Justice of Miami Beach, Fla., president of the National Association of Real Estate Boards; Bill Gove,

sales consultant, and James C. Downs Jr., chairman of the board of the Real Estate Research Corporation, Chicago. PECORA SAID the annual five-day convention is one of the largest in California. Last year, 3,400 CREA members and guests met in Los Angeles.

Burt Smith of Bellflower, CREA president, predicts a comparable turnout this year. Other speakers will be announced later.

Governor Brown will deliver the keynote speech at the opening general session on Tuesday, Oct. 4, Pecora said.

JOHNSON is a former Congressman from Illinois. He will speak the same morning on "Opportunities Un-

limited," a defense of the free enterprise system and look at the future.

Wednesday, Oct. 5, Justice will speak on the goals of organized real estate and the efforts being made nationally to achieve those goals.

Gove of Wiscasset, Me., is one of the nation's best known speakers on salesmanship and is a sales consultant for such corporations as Braniff Airways and General Motors. He will address the group Wednesday, Oct. 5.

Downs, who will speak on the "Realty Outlook" Thursday, Oct. 6, is in great demand for his authoritative comments and predictions on the real estate market, its trends, and prospects.
