

stacks. The precipitators operate like huge magnets to remove pollutants weighing between 75 and 240 pounds each hour. The precipitators have been working around the clock since they were installed in 1951. Pollution control measures have cost U. S. Steel some \$200 million in the past 15 years.

Pollution Control Costs U.S. Steel \$200 Million

United States Steel Corp. has spent an estimated \$200 million for air and water pollution control equipment over the past 15 years, it was reported in the U. S. Steel Quarterly just issued — to more than 335,000 stockholders.

Citing a vast array of technological devices and scientific processes in the plants of U. S. Steel across the country which are designed to combat air and water pollution, the Quarterly explained, U. S. Steel scientists and technicians are constantly working to solve the known problems and are delving into the unknowns, reaching toward the ultimate goal of preventing the causes of air and water pollution at their sources.

Noting the corporation's current facility program, the stockholder report emphasized that it called for average annual expenditures in excess of \$600 million during the three-year period 1966-68 and that the facilities involved will incorporate, as part of their basic design, the latest air and water quality-protection equipment devised by modern technology.

ONE OF THE major problems in the pollution battle is in providing adequate equipment for such facilities as those where costs per unit of production are relatively high — or where the market for their product is diminishing.

U. S. Steel, the Quarterly noted, is working constantly towards the discovery of ways and means of curtailing air and water pollution that will, at the same time, not jeopardize the plants as economic resources to the communities in which they operate.

The stockholder publication emphasized the great range of processes and equipment needed to fight this day-in-day-out war against the constant inroads of this devious enemy.

SOME OF these costly and complex processes and equipment are: Settling—for the treatment of water, this involves permit solids to settle at the bottoms, for harmless removal.

Skimming—steel-making process oil that rises to the surface or retention basins or lagoons is skimmed off.

Filtration—involves filtering process water through deep sands, or through filter cloth, to remove micron-sized particles acquired by water in steel-making.

Chemical treatment — this is used in neutralizing acid and alkaline materials, and to agglomerate solids and oils and gas.

Electrostatic — for the treatment of air, involves cleaning the air that has been used in steel-making processes, by passing it through an electrostatic field, which imparts a negative charge, so that the dust in the air collects on positively charged precipitator elements.

Washing — dirty air is pulled through water in a state of turbulence and the dust caught up in the water droplets is actually washed away.

These and other processes and equipment are described in this detailed Quarterly, which outlines U. S. Steel's strategy to combat this important and complex problem.

Fiesta to Salute Fishing Industry

The 1966 Fishermen's Fiesta, the City of Los Angeles' annual salute to its mammoth \$300 million commercial fishing industry, will be held for three fun-packed days Sept. 30 and Oct. 1 and 2 in San Pedro.

The three-day weekend celebration is an outgrowth of the fishing community's traditional giving of thanks booths, band concerts, tram and harbor boat rides — culminating with a spectacular parade of decorated fishing boats down the main channel of Los Angeles Harbor.

Cost of festooning each ship with vari-colored flags, bunting, banners, and papier-mache flowers can come as high as \$1,000. The boats are decorated in secret and unveiled on the last day of the Fiesta, Sunday, Oct. 2, this year, an hour before the start of the nautical parade. Theme of the Fiesta this year is "Turn Back The Clock," and the winning boat will receive an award of \$2,000. Second and third place awards of \$1,000 and \$750 will be presented and fourth, fifth, and sixth runners-up will receive \$500 each.

LIKE THE Rose Bowl Parade in Pasadena and the annual beauty contest in Long Beach, the Fishermen's Fiesta is one of the most photographed events in the Southland each year. More than 250,000 people visited the 1965 Fiesta. At least 300,000 are expected to view the Fiesta Sept. 30. The affair will be covered by representatives of Southland's news media, by television, radio and newspaper photographers, reporters and news-reel cameramen.

Prominent state and civic leaders have been invited to participate in the Fiesta as honored guests. But the real VIPs, as they are every year, will be the hardy Los Angeles Harbor fishermen and their families.
