Schools Help Tell 'Heart' Story Here

Heart facts are fast becoming entwined with "reading," "writing" and "arithmetic" according to the way the Los Angeles County Health Association's Southwestern Branch has been working with local school administrators and teachers in promoting heart health facts.

"Students at the college level, from those at Harbor College to those in elementary schools in the Centinela Valley, have been receiving 'heartfelt and life-saving information' according to Dr. Daniel D. Hansen, Southwestern Branch medical vice-chairman.

This year, the Inglewood doctor said, the Heart branch hopes to make more "youthful and pounding hearts" become hearts that have learned how to protect themselves with heart health facts.

IN THE PAST year, heart films and literature have been circulated throughout the 20 communities that make up the South Bay, Gardena and Centinela Valley, Harbor, and Palos Verdes areas, he explained.

While most of the material sent to schools is used for heart health education, El Camino and Harbor Colleges have used heart films and literature to professionally instruct their nursing majors about the heart, and how to work with heart disorder victims.

During the last year, teachers have been coming to the Lawndale Heart office for literature such as "Handbook of Heart Terms," "What Teachers Should Know About Children with Heart Disease," "Your Heart and How It Works," and other life-saving reading material that would inform their classes.

STUDENTS HAVE come to the office, 16811 S. Hawthorne Blvd., to get facts for a term paper or for professional advice about artificial hearts as Rick Large, 2230 W. 235th St., did when he contacted Dr. Richard Lescoe of Torrance, thoracic surgeon with the Heart Association.

Besides literature, heart films are available. One example of the 40 films, Dr. Hansen added, is one called "Heart Beat."

The 14½-minute colored film tells about the "unhealthy" impacts of heart and

Art Show Will Feature Work by Indian Youths

The first Southern California exhibition of the work of the young Indian artists at the Institute of American Indian Art in Santa Fe, N.M., will be presented at the Palos Verdes Art Gallery October 2 through 31.

Selected from the permanent honors collection of the Institute, the exhibit includes a large variety of oil paintings, prints, and drawings. Weaving and sculpture are also represented.

Interweaving the traditions of the Indian culture with the techniques of contemporary art, the young artists produce a unique and individual expression. Birds, rattlesnakes, medicine bags, and water serpents continue as subjects but are treated with new freedom.

Exhibitions of the collection have been displayed in New York City's Riverside Museum and The Museum of Contemporary Crafts, in San Francisco's new craft museum, and at the Edinburgh Festival and Berlin Festival.
