We are still having pretty hot weather in most areas so don't forget your watering program.

This is the time to give your roses the last heavy feeding until next season. I like to use a fertilizer containing chelated iron, manganese and zinc to help them with the fall blooming.

If you are having any insect pests, spray with a multi-purpose spray that can be used later for other insect pests.

If there is any danger of mildew or black spot, a preventative rose spray of nicotine and copper is excellent. These two sprays will keep your pests well under control for the balance of the season.

First Aid Course Called An Aid to Safer Driving

Regardless of how much caution and good judgment you may use behind the wheel of your automobile, you will be a safer driver if you've taken a first aid course, the American Red Cross said today.

"Automobile accidents don't always happen to the other person," Capt. Walter West said. "They can and often do happen to any of us, no matter how carefully we drive, and a knowledge of first aid might well mean the difference between life or death."

Even if it does happen to "the other guy" he might be in the car ahead of you and a life could be saved by your knowledge and skill, West, the Torrance-Lomita Red

Cross Branch safety chairman pointed out.

Another major effort by the American Red Cross to combat the unnecessary highway death toll is the formation of mobile first aid units—privately and publicly owned automobiles driven by persons who have had advanced first aid training and carrying emergency equipment.

Today nearly 26,000 such units are in operation, and in addition there are now some 1,800 first aid stations on secondary highways. Similar units are becoming increasingly popular on the water with the training of boat owners and marine operators. "The National Safety Coun-

cil reports some 49,000 persons were killed on highways last year and an additional 1.8 million suffered disabling injuries," Captain West said. "Couple this with the mounting toll on our waterways and it is easy to see the vital role individuals trained in Red Cross first aid and safety techniques can play when accidents occur," he said.

"I FELT DARN good," is how one first aider described his feelings after helping the victim of an accident on a freeway. Although not the first one on the scene, the first aider was the only one who knew what to do for the driver who had been thrown through the windshield. Using the first aid kit he

always carried in his car, he was able to stem the bleeding, bandage the victim for the trip to a hospital and treat for shock before an ambulance arrived. He later learned he was instrumental in saving the motorist's life. The man he treated spent two weeks in the hospital and had 80 stitches taken in his head.

IN ANOTHER accident, a first aid trained spectator saved the life of a doctor, hurt in an automobile crash. He reacted immediately and applied direct pressure to a severed artery. Although the ambulance and the hospital were only minutes away, another life was saved.

"It's the first, precious few minutes after an accident when you must react and almost instinctively do the right thing," Captain West said. "Red Cross training will show you what to do and how. There is no greater reward than being able to say, 'I saved a life.'"

A course in standard first aid is being taught at the Hawthorne Christian School, 13600 Prairie Ave., Hawthorne, on Tuesday.

A Torrance volunteer, Mrs. Edna Root is the Red Cross volunteer instructor at the five class sessions schedule on Tuesdays from 7:30 to 9:30 p.m.
