Sellers Sets Fourth Cross Country Record

West High's cross country team lost a 23-24 decision to Palos Verdes last week, despite another record-breaking performance by Mike Sellers for the Warriors.

Sellers set a new course record over the two-mile Peninsula track to lead all runners. His time, 9:33.1, broke a 10:29.3 course record set last year.

In four starts this year, senior Sellers has established four new records. He set a new "A" division record at

the Long Beach Invitational and also set records on both the Redondo and West courses.

Nine men came in under the old record during the Palos Verdes Meet. Bob Morrison and Bryan Cox paced Sea Kings, finishing two-thirds.

Sophomore Jim Poush paced the West sophomores to a 16-45 victory. Poush cleared the two-miles in 10:46.

Palos Verdes scored a 20-44 win the javayee race and took to the freshman event, 20-37. West's freshmen were paced by Ron Johnson, who finished fourth in 11:42.
