

Work to End This Week On Carson Area Street

Completion of improvements of 223rd Street and the Carson area is expected this week—four months ahead of schedule—according to County Supervisor Burton W. Chace.

Chace said the road, between Figueroa Street and Main Street, has been widened to six lanes and will be opened to traffic immediately.

The project plans and specifications were prepared by the County Road Department and construction was by Sully-Miller Contracting Co. of Long Beach under a \$360,638 contract.

THE WORK on the 1.1-mile section of 223rd Street consisted of reconstructing and widening the two-lane roadway to a fully curbed six-lane highway. Included in the project was the construction of pavement, curb and gutter, walks, driveways, drainage structures, and sewer work.

In addition, the traffic signals at the intersections of 223rd Street with Figueroa Street and with Main Street were improved and signals were installed at the 223rd Street-Moneta Avenue intersection.

"This was one phase of a multi-stage project program for the improvement of a 4.3-mile stretch of 223rd Street between Normandie Avenue and Alameda Street," Chace said. "The improvement of the section from Main Street to Avalon Boulevard was completed in May."

AT CITY'S SCHOOLS

Private Students May Get to Use Libraries

Students at Bishop Montgomery High School may be permitted to use libraries at the city's four public high schools if a plan proposed Monday is approved by the Torrance Board of Education.

Trustees instructed Dr. J. H. Hull, superintendent of schools, to make a study of the proposal to determine if such a plan is legal and if an agreement can be reached between the schools.

Mrs. Kenneth E. Watts called for the study, noting that the city will probably curtail library services when an independent library system is established here in July, 1968.

STUDENTS from Montgomery High reportedly are heavy users of the Torrance library facilities, which currently are backed up by the Los Angeles County Library System.

All four Torrance high schools now keep their libraries open in the afternoon or evening hours for students, she said. Mrs. Watts also noted the libraries in the four high schools are rated among the finest in the state.
