German Measles Cases Now Must Be Reported

Practicing physicians must now report all cases of German measles (rubella) to local health departments, Dr. G. A. Heidebreder, County Health Officer announced today.

This requirement, now included in the California Administrative Code, Title 17, Public Health, became effective Nov. 20. This reporting will make it possible to measure the extent of an epidemic and hence project the number of birth defects that may occur, said Dr. Heidebreder.

German measles usually causes only a mild illness, but is a grave danger when it occurs in women during the early months of pregnancy. In the 1963-65 German measles epidemic, one of the worst experienced in the country, it was estimated that one out of every six expectant mothers infected with German measles gave birth to an infant with some defect.

The most common defects following maternal rubella include blindness (congenital cataract), hearing impairment, and heart or brain damage.

Reporting of all cases will make the job of control much easier, Dr. Heidebreder said.
