Dorothy Digs

There are still plenty of bulbs in your local garden center and it is not too late to plant for that bright spring bloom in most areas. It is best to prepare the soil by digging deeply and spading in some steer manure.

If there is any sign of fungus, treat the whole area with a copper ether solution before planting.

Follow the directions for depth of planting as noted by your garden center. The depths vary from surface to 8" deep and you should get them right.

I like to dip bulbs subject to thrip in a nicotine solution for one half hour before planting. I use 1 1/2 teaspoons of a 12 per cent spray per gallon of water then plant while the bulbs are still wet.
