Fire Big Danger During Holidays

To keep the yule season a joyous one, care with fire during the Christmas and New Year holiday period was urged today by the American Insurance Association.

"Every day more than 1,000 American homes are struck by fire," said J. Dewey Dorsett, president of the association. "Every 44 minutes fire claims a life."

"One of every four fires in our country is the result of carelessness," Dorsett added. "If we use ordinary care, we can hold down our tragic fire toll."

FIRE LOSSES in the United States this year will top \$1 billion, Dorsett said. Fire deaths will exceed 11,000.

"Make sure that some careless act in your home will not bring the fire department running during the Christmas season," he added.

He gave these recommendations:

- Be careful with matches and smoking, which cause every fifth fire in the United States.
 - Be sure electrical appliances are operating properly and are in good repair. Misuse of electricity and faulty electrical equipment also are responsible for one-fifth of all fires.
 - In particular, keep fire away from the Christmas tree. Do not stand too near the tree with a lighted pipe or cigarette. And replace or discard the tree immediately if it becomes dry.
- "I AM stressing fire safety during the holiday season because that is the time we most want to avoid fires so that all may have a joyous Christmas," Dorsett said.
- "However, fire prevention is not just a holiday stunt. Fire prevention is a year-round job, and after the holidays we should continue to keep our homes fire safe."

County Building Group To Advise Supervisors

Funds for Soil Test Approved

Funds for testing the soil and foundation for comfort stations at the proposed South Coast Botanic Gardens have been authorized, according to Supervisor Burton W. Chace.

The Board of Supervisors has allocated \$1,350 for a foundation study, he explained.

As its first order of business, the committee is studying a list of projects being planned at a total cost of \$100,000. From this list, several will be selected for study.

"Engineers have indicated one of the sites chosen may not be suitable," Chace said. "Tests will indicate where the station can be built without fear of a weak foundation."

The testing includes the drilling of six deep holes as a basis for a soils investigation report and recommendations. The firm of LeRoy Crandal and Associates was selected to perform the tests.
