Clam Canapes

Hot Cheese Bits

Flatten one eight-ounce package refrigerator biscuits to one-eighth inch thickness. Brush with one beaten egg white and sprinkle with one-half cup American blue cheese (about 3 ounces, crumbled). Bake in 450° oven for ten-twelve minutes or until lightly browned. Cut in squares serve warm.
