

Conferences For Parents Successful

Nearly 20,000 Torrance parents returned to school this fall, according to Dr. Albert N. Posner, assistant superintendent.

In a report to the Board of Education, Dr. Posner said that 16,095 parents of elementary school students participated in group conferences and 3,375 high school parents attended "back-to-school" nights.

Parents of departmentalized seventh and eighth grade students met with each of their child's teachers in 25 schools and with the homeroom teacher and some of the other teachers in the remaining schools, the report indicated.

Ex-San Quentin Inmate To Speak at El Camino

Bill Sands, author of the best-selling book, "My Shadow Ran Fast," will present a special lecture program Jan. 5 at 8 p.m. in the El Camino College Campus Theater.

A former inmate of San Quentin Prison, Sands now spends his time writing and lecturing about his experiences and what made him change the direction of his life.

His book is his autobiography, and was described by former San Quentin Warden Clinton Duffy as "An excel-

lent portrayal of a very mixed-up and dangerous young man who discovered the true meaning of life while serving time."

Sands is now devoting his energy and talent to organizing rehabilitation programs to help convicts and ex-convicts. He lectures extensively to audiences across the country on the prevention of juvenile delinquency, prison reform and rehabilitation.

As part of this work, he is the founder of the 7th Step Foundation, a non-profit or-

ganization which works with men in prisons to help get them ready to become useful citizens again. The foundation conducts pre-release classes for inmates as well as works with those who are newly released from prison.

Sands, who will appear at El Camino under the sponsorship of the Moral and Spiritual Values Committee of the faculty, will also present his message to the faculty during a morning lecture. Admission to the evening lecture is free.
