Supervisors Impose Tax On Music Center Tickets

A 10 per cent tax on paid admissions at the Music Center operation self-sustaining has been approved by county supervisors.

Supervisors last week adopted an ordinance establishing the special tax.

"This law will take \$600,000 off the backs of the property taxpayer," Supervisor Burton W. Chace said. "It is a step toward making the Music Center operation self-sustaining."

345 Cards Recalled By County

An inquiry into the use of telephone credit cards by county employes has resulted in the recall of 345 cards, according to Supervisor Kenneth Hahn.

Hahn said the study was requested in April in a move for maximum efficiency and economy in county government.

He also has called for a re-evaluation of the use of telephone credit cards by county employes, noting that the annual telephone bill for county government exceeds \$4,115,000.

CHIEF Administrative Officer L. S. Hollinger said the remaining 1,322 credit cards in the hand of county employes are used primarily by field inspectors who must keep close contact with their headquarters.

The CAO's report also points out the use of these cards is closely checked by supervisory personnel, and that the use of the telephone credit card is less expensive than a collect call or submission of a reimbursement claim.
