Two Given Jail Terms; Third Man Fined \$150

Six month jail terms were given two admitted burglars of the Newton Medical Center Monday by Superior Court Judge John Shidler. A third member of the burglary trio was ordered to pay a fine of \$150.


Both Brusick and Zankich also were placed on three years probation.


