

5.5 Million Youths Head Back to School in State

Enrollment in California's public schools, kindergarten through the 14th year in junior college, will be 150,000 more this fall than last September—an increase greater than the total pupil enrollment in six states.

A total of 5.5 million part-time and full-time pupils and 180,000 full-time teachers—more than one-quarter of California's total population of approximately 20 million—will answer the public school bell this fall as the annual summer vacation ends. This is the third year California's total enrollment has surpassed the 5 million mark.

These figures are projections for the 1967-68 school year prepared by the California State Department of Education.

Additional statistics from

the department and the California Teachers Association (CTA) show that:

- Total 13th and 14th grade (junior college) enrollment will be 300,000 this year, compared to 284,000 last year. This increase of 16,000—5.6 per cent—in one year makes the junior colleges one of the fastest growing sectors in the state's educational system.
- Total kindergarten enrollment this year will be 383,000, compared to 374,000 last year—A 2.4 per cent increase.
- Total 1st through 8th grade enrollment will be 2,790,000 this year, compared to 2,715,000 last year—a 2.8 per cent increase.
- Total 9th through 12th grade enrollment will be 1,185,000 this year, compared to 1,148,000 last year—a 3.2

per cent increase.

- Total full-time enrollment at all campuses of the State College System will be 120,000 this year, compared to 111,000 last year—an 8.1 per cent increase.
- Total full-time enrollment at all campuses of the University of California will be 87,000 this year, compared to 80,250 last year—an 8.4 per cent increase.
- Total enrollment for adults and special school classes for the handicapped will be 825,000, compared to 771,245 last year—a 7.0 per cent increase.
- California's elementary and secondary schools will have 8,500 more full-time teachers on the payroll this year than last year.
- About 70,000 pupils will be on half-day sessions this year. This is approximately


