

First Methodist Church Will Burn Its Mortgage

Members of the congregation at the First Methodist Church of Torrance, 1551 El Prado, will hold mortgage burning services Sunday at 9:30 and 11 a.m.

The services will begin a special day of thanksgiving for paying off the mortgage on the church.

The Sanctuary was officially dedicated by Bishop Gerald Kennedy Oct. 29, 1961. The mortgage will be burned Sunday by Mervin Schwab, chairman of the building committee; Milton Isbell, committee treasurer; Carl Bose, present finance committee chairman; and John Flanagan, chairman of the church's Board of Trustees.

The First Methodist Church was organized in 1923 and has gone through five building programs. The membership now numbers 1,475.

Works by El Camino Decorating Teachers on Exhibit Class Set In Redondo

Bronze Sculpture and a 15-foot mural are included in the two-man art show by El Camino art instructors Fotis Korkis and Andrew Fagan, now at the Palos Verdes Art Gallery, 2400 Via Campanina, Palos Verdes Estates.

The large multi-colored mural, "Genesis of Atomic Energy," is a print and took Korkis a year to develop. There are also 17 original prints in the exhibit.

The bronze sculpture by Fagan, "Gloed 23," is abstracted from the female form and water forms. Reflections also are part of the sculpture which are mounted on jet black.

WORKS OF both Fagan and Korkis has been exhibited nationally. Korkis attained his master's degree from the Otis Art Institute.

In 1965 Fagan exhibited in the International Sculpture Symposium in Long Beach. He is listed in the Historical Archives of Contemporary Art of Sao Paulo Biennial.

KORKIS HAS won awards throughout the country and is a member of the honorary art society, Kappi Pi. His prints, painting, ceramics and sculpture have been shown in Pennsylvania, Oklahoma, North Dakota and California. There is no charge for admission to the gallery, located in the library building at 2400 Via Campanina. The gallery is open weekdays from 1 to 4 p.m. and Sundays from 3 to 5 p.m.
