Just to name a few — 20th Century Fox, on the 91 line, Universal Studios on the 81 Line, NBC on the 86 Line and CBS on the 89 and 44 Line. Q. Can I get to downtown Los Angeles and Long Beach from Carson & Avalon, also the Naval Station on Terminal Island by RTD? Mrs. B.


A. The RTD 37 Line running north on Avalon Boulevard will take you to downtown Los Angeles, but for Long Beach, you will have to take the 37 Line south and transfer to 86 Line east on Anaheim Street. To go to the Naval Station on Terminal Island, catch the terminal Island bus line in downtown Long Beach on Ocean Boulevard.

Q. I was telling my older brother, he's 18, about my Student Privilege Card and he said, "Kid stuff! What good is it?" Will you tell him it isn't so? He won't believe me. B.B.

A. If saving 50% on bus fare anywhere on the system, seven days a week, or discounts on many attractions, including college football, is kid stuff, then they should rename the Student Privilege Card to "Kid Stuff Card." I'm with you B.B.; kids have more fun anyway.
