

November Death Toll Increases

SACRAMENTO — Traffic deaths during November increased on California highways, as compared to a year ago, but the total for the year still was slightly under that for 1966.

The California Highway Patrol said 448 persons were killed during November, as compared to 424 a year ago. Through November, 4,349 persons had been killed in traffic accidents. For the first 11 months of 1966, there were 4,378 traffic fatalities.

Arrests by CHP officers continued to climb. The total through November was 1,759,049, including 34,512 for drunk driving. This compared to 1,471,848, including 23,608 for drunk driving during the first 11 months of

Area Man Gets Two Jail Terms

Johnny Wallace Hedman, 23, of 4417 W. 226th St., was sentenced Monday to a double term, to run concurrently, in state prison.

Judge Bernard Lawler handed down the sentences after Hedman entered guilty pleas to second-degree robbery and possession of marijuana.

The robbery charge stems from the Nov. 9 robbery of the Village Pharmacy, when \$179 was taken. The marijuana charge was lodged after police stopped Hedman last Sept. 8 on a traffic violation and found a bag which contained marijuana.

Hedman waived his right to talk to probation officers and asked the judge to sentence him at once.

The drug charge was dropped after analysis of a capsule which he had at the time of his arrest. Analysis showed the capsule did not contain a dangerous drug.

School Teacher Injured When Vehicles Collide


A Torrance schoolteacher was rushed to Little Company of Mary Hospital early Monday afternoon after she was injured in a traffic accident.

Also involved in the collision was a stake truck driven by Raymond H. Reese, 52, of 1909 W. 222nd St.


Tract Approved
