

# San Pedro Elks Begin New Lodge

Construction of a new lodge for the San Pedro Elks Lodge 966 has been started, following formal groundbreaking ceremonies at the site.

A contract for the construction has been awarded to Jackson Brothers Construction Co. of Los Angeles on a low bid of \$648,000. The new facility is to be completed within 180 working days.

Located on an 11-acre site at 1748 Cumbre Drive, the new lodge will overlook the Los Angeles Harbor complex. The two-level structure, designed by Architects DeRosa and Daly of Long Beach, contains 33,150 square feet. Grand Exalted Ruler Raymond C. Dodson headed the dignitaries participating in groundbreaking ceremonies. Also present were two past Grand Exalted Rulers, R. Leonard Busi, and Horace R. Wisely.

Assemblyman Vincent Thomas (D-San Pedro) and Los Angeles City Councilman John S. Gibson, also attended the ceremonies.

The statewide California Elks Association was represented by Gerald Strohm, president, and John Germer, vice president for the South Central District. Harry W. Jordan and Marvin Pike, both district deputies for the statewide group, also were present.

Furnishings for the new lodge will be purchased with funds realized from the sale of the old lodge building. The structure was built in 1911, according to Dodson.

An Olympic-size swimming pool will be added at a later date.

The new lodge will include an octagon-shaped lodge room which can seat 400 persons. Health club facilities, locker rooms, and sauna baths will occupy the lower level.

The stained glass windows in the present building, as well as the chandeliers and all lodge station chairs will be incorporated in the new building.

## Armed Forces Original Recipes

### Use Goulash Mix

Contestants from women's organizations throughout Southern California competed by preparing their original recipes using Lawry's new Beef Goulash Seasoning Mix.

Mrs. Donald Morden of Canoga Park, representing the San Fernando Home Economists in Homemaking, won first prize — a new O'Keefe & Merritt Contempo III gas range.

Here for you to try is her recipe along with those of the second and third place winners.

#### SPICY BEEF BOATS

- 1 lb. ground beef
- 1 pkg. Lawry's Goulash Seasoning Mix
- 1/4 C. water
- 1/4 C. finely chopped celery
- 3/4 C. grated Cheddar cheese
- 1 tsp. monosodium glutamate
- 12 French rolls
- 1/2 tsp. garlic powder
- 1/4 C. margarine, melted

Combine ground beef with goulash seasoning mix, water, celery, 1/2 cup of the cheese, and monosodium glutamate. Hollow out French rolls. Add garlic powder to melted margarine. Brush on outside of rolls. Fill rolls with meat mixture and sprinkle with remaining 1/4 cup of cheese. Place on cookie sheet and bake in modern gas oven at 350° for 45 minutes. Makes 12 rolls.

#### HUNGARIAN LESCO

- (Sausages with Vegetables)
- 2 Tbsp. butter
- 2 tender stalks celery sliced
- 2 large bell peppers, seeded and sliced
- 4 large fresh mushrooms, sliced
- 1 can (16-oz.) beer
- 1 pkg. Lawry's Goulash Seasoning Mix
- 4 large tomatoes, peeled and cut in wedges
- 6 sausages (about 1 1/2 lbs.) (Smoked Polish sausage, knockwurst, Kolbasi or

other spicy sausages may be used.)

Heat butter in large skillet. Add celery, cover and cook for 5 minutes over simmer flame. Add peppers and mushrooms. Cover and cook 7 minutes longer, stirring occasionally. Add beer. Stir in goulash seasoning mix and blend well. Add tomatoes. Place sausages on top of vegetables and simmer, covered, for 15 minutes. (Sausages may be sliced, if desired.) Serve with small new potatoes garnished with parsley and thick slices of bread. Makes 4 to 6 servings.

#### MAGYAR EGGPLANT

- 1 eggplant
- 2 eggs, beaten
- Bread crumbs
- Olive oil or salad oil
- 1 pkg. Lawry's Goulash Seasoning Mix
- 1 1/2 C. water
- Parmesan cheese

Peel eggplant. Slice in pieces 1/4 inch thick. Dip slices in eggs, then in bread crumbs. Heat oil in heavy skillet. Brown slices of eggplant. Combine goulash seasoning mix and water. Simmer until thick, about 7 minutes. In a greased casserole, alternate layers of eggplant, sauce and cheese, ending with a generous amount of sauce and cheese. Bake in a modern gas oven at 350° until heated through, about 30 minutes. Makes 4 to 6 servings.
