Use of Audio-Visual Materials Increases

The use of audio-visual materials such as films and records has grown considerably in the past year, Betty Addison, Torrance regional librarian, said today.

Although adult films are widely circulated, borrowing

is particularly brisk in children's 16 millimeter sound films, with their all time favorites being "Madeline," "And Now Miguel," and "Paladini," Miss Addison said.

In addition to use of these films by individuals, checking out is continually done by groups such as Campfire Girls, Scouts, the "Y," and religious organizations. Films are also borrowed for showing at a local school for retarded children, which has two screenings a week. Most popular with these handicapped youngsters are films using brilliant music and bright colors.

KING CRAB SHELLS
2 (7 1/2 oz.) cans Alaska king crab
1 cup mayonnaise.
1/2 cup chopped celery.
1/4 cup chopped green pepper.
1 tsp. sliced green onion.
1 tsp. Worcestershire sauce
1/2 tsp. dry mustard.
1/2 tsp. salt.
Dash of pepper.
Buttered bread crumbs, toasted.

Drain crab; slice larger pieces. Combine all ingredients except crumbs; mix lightly. Place in individual shells. Sprinkle with crumbs and bake at 350 degrees for 30 minutes. Garnish with parsley sprigs. Serves 6.

SALMON MACARONI SUPPER

For 4 to 6 servings:
1 lb. can pink or red salmon.
1/2 c. uncooked elbow macaroni (or noodles).
3 tbs. butter or margarine
3 tbs. flour.
2 c. liquid (salmon liquid plus milk).
1 c. grated American cheese, medium or sharp.
1/2 tsp. salt.
2 tbs. sweet pickle relish or chopped sweet pickle
1 c. coarsely crushed potato chips.

(For 2 to 3 servings: use 7/8 oz. can of salmon and half of the above quantities.)
Drain salmon and save liquid. Cook macaroni in 1 qt. boiling salted water until tender. Drain well. Melt butter in skillet; stir in flour until smooth. Add liquid and cook, stirring frequently until mixture has thickened. Stir in cheese, salt and pickle relish. When cheese has melted, remove from heat and add flaked salmon and macaroni. Place in 1 1/2 qt. casserole and sprinkle potato chips around edge. Bake 10-15 minutes in 400 degree oven or until bubbly.




