Claims for Exemptions Due Earlier

Church and welfare exemptions have been mailed for all properties which received the exemption last year, according to County Assessor Philip E. Watson. Claim forms for veteran exemption will be mailed Feb. 13.

Earlier deadlines had been set for the filing of property-tax exemption claims. Welfare exemption claims must be filed before 5 p.m., March 15, and 5 p.m., April 17, is the deadline for filing veteran and church exemptions.

"All claims for welfare exemptions must be routed through the State Board of Equalization in Sacramento, and no assessor may grant a welfare claim that the board finds ineligible," Watson said.

Garden Checklist

1. Fuchsias may be pruned anytime during the next two or three weeks. Like roses, they bloom on new growth and can stand rather severe pruning.
2. Right now during bare root planting season is the most economical time to buy roses, fruit trees, berries, shade trees and many deciduous flowering shrubs.
3. Feed cyclamen as you would begonias—with liquid fish fertilizer. Potted plants need more frequent feeding and watering than do those in the open ground.
4. Many overwintering insects and pests can be eliminated right now by a thorough winter spraying. Also spray peach trees now to control leaf curl. Another spray will be needed when buds begin to show.
5. Geraniums and pelargoniums may be cut back this month if you haven't pruned them already.
