

Fremont Champ In City

Now that Fremont High School has regained city basketball supremacy, the Pathfinders' "rookie" head coach Gaston Green is the toast of Los Angeles prepdom. His team scored an impressive 81-66 victory over Manual Arts before a 7,000 spectators at UCLA's Pauley Pavilion last Saturday.

The Pathfinders finished the 1966-67 season with a 16-win, 2-loss record and avenged their only two losses of the season by dumping defending city champion Jordan, 69-48, in the semi-finals.

Earlier, Fremont bowed to Jordan, 84-82, in a non-league meeting and lost to Manual Arts, 86-83, in the second half of Southern League play.

In the championship finale, Curtis Rowe, Fremont's 6-6 center who established city regular season scoring records for most points and game average in a 10-game campaign, scored 29 points and dominated control of the backboards with 18 rebounds.

LAKERS MIX WITH PHILLY AT L.A. ARENA

Alex Hannum's Philadelphia 76ers, en route to becoming the winningest team in the history of professional basketball, bring their high-powered offense to the Sports Arena tonight for an 8:30 engagement with the Los Angeles Lakers.

Wilt Chamberlain and his star-studded supporting cast will be participating in another of the Lakers' Ladies' Night attractions.

The Lakers have yet to win from the 76ers this season, but are in their finest physical condition of the year and hope to give the rugged Philly front line of Chamberlain, Chet Walker and Lucious Jackson a better battle on the boards with the recent addition of seven-foot Mel Counts.

The 76ers have lost five of 53 games, including three to Boston.

Two previous meetings between L. A. and Philly at the Sports Arena resulted in 129-123 and 118-107 Philadelphia victories.

Jerry West had 40 points in the first game and Elgin Baylor potted 30 in the second, but both times the Lakers were outshot and out-rebounded.




