Around the World

with Stan Delaplane

ACAPULCO, MEXICO — (for Spanish and German.) I All the big airlines fly jets carry one with me for what direct into this sunny Pacific coast resort now. No need to using Bed time reading and transfer in Mexico. City use the next day gets me talking like a mynah bird.

They've cut a new and modern airport into an arm of the bay. (Though they do have to run a cow off the runway occasionally.)

It's not too well known that you can stop over here and fly on to the South Pacific. Day after tomorrow, I pick up the QANTAS flight coming from London and New York and fly down to Auckland, New Zealand and Sydney, Australia.

You get a few days in the sun here. And it's a shorter jump down under.

"We are still in college and don't have too much money but want to get to the South Pacific... Can we work on a ship?"

"What was the low-cost cruise? You wrote about it but didn't say what ship."

That was P-and-O's round-the-world Magellan cruise, \$21 a day. That includes everything — shore excursions, too. You can get other cruises as low as \$15 a day. A good one going through the Caribbean to London stops over here in Acapulco. You could write for their attractive folders: Troy Garrison, P-and-O Lines, 155 Post Street, San Francisco.

"If you could give us a list of charter flights we could get on..."

The seamen's unions man the ships. Their members come first, and it's impossible to work without a union permit. However — there's always an occasional yacht around Honolulu or Los Angeles or San Francisco with an owner on short money. You can make a deal to work and pay something, not much. This requires hanging around the yacht harbors until something turns up headed in your direction. Example: my daughter crewed over on a 40-foot Australian boat, Honolulu to San Francisco for about \$30.

I don't get lists of charters. These are group fares available to membership organizations. You have to be a member for six months. There is a new group travel fare—GIT. Ask any travel agent or any airline about it.

"Where should we shop for leather in Spain?"

Loewe's on the Gran Via is the best. You can't buy leather just anywhere in Spain. Gloves may lose their color—on your hands. Shoes are cheap. Look great. And wear out in three months. For shoes and gloves, the best place is Rome.

"Where would I buy, at best price, German hi-fi equipment?"

I've bought them (Telefunken brand) in Germany and at Shannon Free Airport in Ireland. About the same price. Much cheaper than buying them in the U.S. But consider this: Under the new U.S. Customs rules, you'll pay duty on it all unless you carry it back yourself. If it has to be shipped, you get no advantage.

"We will be driving in England (as you suggested) and would like to know if children are allowed in pubs."

No. That's a problem traveling with young children. You can't make those attractive little snack pubs for lunch. Find a place that says "Fully Licensed Restaurant." In hotels, children aren't allowed in the bar either.

"I will be in Spain for several months. Will my electrical equipment work there?"

Spain runs on 110 volts as we do. But they run 50 cycles instead of our 60 cycles. So your electric clock or record player would run but run slow. Anything not on a timed operation will work. You'll have to get a converter plug there to fit their wall sockets.

"Do all the European airports charge an airport tax?"

Can't remember all of them, but it seems to me they do. If you must know exactly, TWA and Pan American can tell you by phone. It's about \$2 as you leave the country.

"We had some French in school. I would like to brush up on it before we take our trip..."

Best I've found is "Magic Key to French" by Margarita Madrigal. She has the same
