# 'Dead' Tooth Is Better Than Average False One

(This is one of a series of articles on dental health prepared by the Harbor Dental Society, an affiliate of the American Dental Association.)

The primary task of dentistry is not to extract teeth, but to preserve them.

By partially or fully removing a tooth's diseased or injured nerve, your dentist may be able to keep a tooth in your mouth which otherwise would be lost. The so-called "dead" or devitalized teeth

can last just as long as normal teeth and are usually superior to false ones.

Treatment of teeth with an injured or destroyed nerve is called endodontics.

ENDODONTIC treatment is used when the tooth pulp—the innermost core of the tooth which contains the nerves and blood vessels—has been injured or attacked by deep decay. Such a tooth may become infected; the germs causing the infection can spread throughout the en-

tire pulp, eventually reaching the jawbone and damaging it.

If the diseased portion of the pulp is removed and the germs destroyed, healing takes place—just as it does in any other part of the body. A protective layer of "secondary" dentin will form where the pulp has been only partially removed. Where the jawbone has become involved, the bone will grow back normally once the infection is gone.

SOMETIMES only part of the pulp need be removed, sometimes removal of the entire pulp is required. In either

case, the dentist will fill the pulp canal with a special material and cap the tooth to prevent penetration of bacteria or fluids. The fibers which attach the tooth to its socket continue to hold firm.

Endodontic therapy is being used more and more to save even "baby" teeth, whose retention in the mouth is so important to properly positioned permanent teeth.

ENDODONTIC therapy is successful more than 95 percent of the time.

So healthy and strong are these pulp-treated teeth that they can even be used as an anchor for a partial denture replacing those teeth that could not be saved by endodontic treatment.
