

ORDINANCE NO. 1748
AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE, CALIFORNIA, ORDERING THE CITY ENGINEER TO PREPARE AND GIVING NOTICE OF A SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD FOR THE CITY OF TORRANCE, CALIFORNIA, ON APRIL 18, 1967, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF SAID CITY A PROPOSITION TO INCUR BONDED INDEBTEDNESS BY SAID CITY FOR A CERTAIN MUNICIPAL IMPROVEMENT, AND WHEREAS, at a meeting held prior to the meeting at which this ordinance was adopted, the City Council, by a vote of at least a majority of the members thereof, adopted a resolution determining that the public interest and necessity demand the acquisition and construction of certain municipal improvement, and making findings relating thereto.

Section 1. That a special election shall be held in said city on April 18, 1967, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of said city the proposition hereinafter set forth, in the principal amount of \$2,350,000, to incur bonded indebtedness for the purpose of financing the acquisition and construction of certain municipal improvement, and making findings relating thereto.

Section 2. That the estimated cost of the municipal improvement described in said ballot proposition is the sum of \$2,350,000. The estimated cost of the municipal improvement includes the following: (a) legal or other fees incidental to or connected with the acquisition, issuance and sale of the bonds and other costs and expenses incidental to or connected with the acquisition, issuance and sale of the bonds.

Section 3. That the maximum rate of interest to be paid on said indebtedness shall not exceed the maximum rate permitted by law, but not more than six percent (6%) per annum, the actual rate or rates of interest on said bonds to be determined prior to the time of the sale of said bonds. Said interest shall be payable semi-annually, except that interest for the first year shall be made payable at the end of said year.

Section 4. That the polls for said election shall be opened at seven o'clock A.M. of the day of said election and shall remain open continuously from said time until 7 o'clock P.M. of the same day, when said polls shall be closed. The provisions of Section 14436 of the Elections Code of the State of California shall apply.

Section 5. That on the ballots to be used at said special election, in addition to any other matters required to be printed and printed substantially the following: **MARK CROSS (+) ON BALLOT ONLY.** The words "YES" and "NO" shall be printed in large, bold, black letters, and shall be printed in the following order: **YES** and **NO**. All marks except the cross (+) and the words "YES" and "NO" are forbidden and make the ballot void.

Section 6. That a cross (+) placed in the voting square after the word "YES" in the manner herein provided shall be counted in favor of the adoption of the proposition. A cross (+) placed in the voting square after the word "NO" in the manner herein provided shall be counted against the adoption of the proposition.

Section 7. That if the proposition for the incurring of bonded indebtedness to submit to the qualified voters of said city, in not exceeding the principal amount stated in such proposition, is adopted, the City Engineer shall be authorized to acquire, construct, install, maintain, repair, and operate the following: (a) a new public library building and additions to and extensions and improvements of existing public library buildings, including vehicle parking facilities, and (b) the acquisition, construction, installation, maintenance, repair, and operation of land, furniture, furnishings, equipment and books necessary therefor.

Section 8. That a cross (+) placed in the voting square after the word "YES" in the manner herein provided shall be counted in favor of the adoption of the proposition. A cross (+) placed in the voting square after the word "NO" in the manner herein provided shall be counted against the adoption of the proposition.
