

Hahn Hits Medi-Cal Proposal

A State Senate proposal to alter the Medi-Cal bill and shift the cost of hospital care from the state to county taxpayers could result in a tax increase of four cents per \$100 assessed valuation, Supervisor Kenneth Hahn declared today. Hahn, who said he was "shocked" by the proposal, said the plan "is completely without sound fiscal foundation." The plan as advanced in the State Senate would eliminate the option method of state reimbursement of funds to counties for medical treatment of indigent persons, Hahn said. "Every taxpayers' group should write their state senators from Los Angeles demanding that the burden not be shifted to county taxpayers when Medi-Cal is traditionally a state program and state responsibility," Hahn said.
