### Entry Deadline Saturday For County Beauty Contest

Deadline for the Miss Los Angeles County Beauty Pageant is July 1, according to County Supervisor Burton W. Chace.

He pointed out that applications may be obtained by calling the County Department of Parks and Recreation.

The annual beauty contest will be held at Marina del Rey on Aug. 6. To be eligible, contestants must be residents of Los Angeles County, must never have been married, and must be within the ages of 16 and 22.

Winner of the pageant will receive several prizes. She will compete for the title of "Maid of California" in Sacramento on Sept. 10, ride on a Rose Tournament float New Year's Day, and make personal appearances for the County of Los Angeles, sponsor of the contest.

In addition to the title and trophy, Miss Los Angeles County will receive a free weekend on the summer resort of Catalina Island.

Civil defense siren systems in Los Angeles County will be tested Friday at 10 a.m. in the usual month-end test of equipment, Sheriff Peter J. Pitchess said today.

## Weight Limits Increased On Parcel Post Packages

Mailers will be able to send 25-pound parcels between first class post offices which are 150 miles or more apart starting July 1, Postmaster Carl L. Backlund has reminded patrons. The present weight limit is 20 pounds, he said.

This is the first of five increases scheduled to take effect annually until 1971, when a 40-pound, 84-inch maximum size will be authorized between all first class post offices. Size limitations are now 72 inches in combined girth and length.

The next increase, due July 1, 1968, will raise the weight limit to 30 pounds. On July 1, 1969, the weight limit will be increased from 30 to 40 pounds; on July 1, 1970, the size will be increased to 78 inches; and on July 1, 1971,

the size is scheduled to be increased to 84 inches.

Backlund also said parcels weighing up to 40 pounds can be mailed between first class post offices less than 150 miles apart. Packages addressed to and from 2nd, 3rd, and 4th class post offices, Alaska and Hawaii are not affected by the increase in size and weight provisions of the Public Law 89-573, which became effective Jan. 15, he said. Parcel post mailings to and from these offices remain at 70 pounds and 100 inches.


