Memorial Service for Lomita Minister Held

Memorial services for the Rev. William A. Kendall, 49, were held at the Wayside Methodist Church in Lomita at 11 a.m. yesterday as final tribute to the popular minister who died in an Arizona vehicle accident.

The Rev. Mr. Kendall, who had been pastor of the Wayside church at 25904 Cayuga Ave., Lomita, for more than a year, was dead in his vehicle after it crashed near Chandler, Ariz.

A former pastor at Chandler, the Rev. Mr. Kendall had taken two of his daughters there to visit friends and was returning to Lomita alone when the accident occurred, friends told the Press-Herald.

A MEMBER of a family of Methodist ministers, the Lomita pastor began his ministry in the Indiana Conference and came to California where he served in Pasadena. While there he completed work on his master of theology degree at the University of Southern California.

He served as a missionary to the First Korean Methodist Church in Hilo, Hawaii, from 1945 to 1950, and then returned to California where he served congregations at San Luis Obispo, at the Vine Street Methodist Church of Hollywood, and then in Arizona.

His father, the Rev. Landy H. Kendall, served as a minister in the Indiana Conference, and an older brother, Dr. Charles F. Kendall, is now pastor of the First Methodist Church of Hollywood. The Lomita pastor had just been reassigned to the Wayside church at the conference held recently in Redlands.

SURVIVING HIM here are his widow, Elsa, and four daughters. The eldest daughter, Heidi, is a student at California Western University in San Diego; Lellani was graduated in June from Narbonne High School; Marty is scheduled to enter Narbonne High in the fall, and Wendy is an elementary school student.

The Rev. Mr. Kendall had taken Wendy and Marty to Arizona and was returning when he died. The girls flew home Wednesday evening.

Saturday's memorial service was under the direction of the Rev. Dr. J. Irwin Trotter, superintendent of the Long Beach District of the Methodist Conference, and the Rev. Kenneth Doctor, former pastor in this area and a close personal friend of the Kendall family.
