Burning Refuse May Provide Electricity

American ingenuity never seems to be at a loss. Take garbage, for instance. It's still being incinerated to get rid of it, but in the process many big cities across the country are now planning to harness the heat caused by incineration to produce power and also keep pollution down. Unfortunately, many of the incinerators now being used are not capable of producing power. However, special refuse-for-power incinerators are now available and big cities are planning to install them in the near future.

In New York City a proposal was made recently to build a refuse-fueled power plant on the site of the old Brooklyn Navy Yard. This plant would not only dispose of 3,500 tons of garbage per day, but provide enough power to heat Manhattan office buildings in the winter and run air conditioners in the summer.

The refuse-for-power premise is simple: utilize the heat of incineration to boil water and use the resultant steam to drive turbines for electricity.

The new incinerators are said to be capable of keeping soot and fly ash to a minimum—as little as 1 per cent. And, because refuse contains practically no sulfur content, using it instead of coal or oil means sulfur dioxide, a prime air pollutant, is kept at a minimum.

INDUSTRY'S search for faster ways to get a job done often leads to some interesting and useful manufacturing systems.

One of these has been announced by a Detroit, Mich., chemical manufacturer. The Northwest Chemical Co., a unit of Chemtron Corp., says that it has designed the first automated system for handling bulky dry caustic soda. The system, Northwest says, cuts the time required to weigh chemicals and load them into mixers to 90 seconds. Previously it required from 15 to 30 minutes to accomplish the weighing and loading operation manually using chemicals from drums.

Moisture must be kept from the caustic soda which Northwest now bulk-stores in a silo on the roof of its plant. To accomplish this, the firm designed a closed recirculating air system with a silica gel drier. The caustic soda is blown directly from the delivery truck into the silo using the dry air.

Gravity feeds the soda and two other chemicals into an automatic weighing device that weighs out just the right amount of each and then transfers the chemicals to mixers.

IF YOU THINK exploring caves should be a gamble try Meramec Caverns, 55 miles southwest of St. Louis, Mo. Some 25 pinball machines were installed in the cave recently for some who might get bored looking at the rocks. . . . A building owner in New York appreciates art so much that he had a five-story abstract mural painted on the outer wall of his apartment house. . . . Moving firms expect record summer business because of corporate transfers, so much so that one vine plans to hire 2,000 college students to handle the rush.

Better steels are in the offing — not only to meet the critical needs of manned space travel but also for such down-to-earth conveniences as high-speed commuter trains, supersharp razor blades, budget-priced air conditioners and rust-resistant auto bodies.

The improvement will result from technological advances that also promise substantial cost savings. Now gaining wide acceptance among major steel producers, for example, is the so-called basic oxygen process. Pure oxygen is injected into a glowing mass of molten pig iron and scrap. The oxygen forces its way through the bubbling mass, quickly burning out the impurities and transforming the mixture into high-grade alloy steel with specified characteristics.

ANOTHER promising technological innovation is scale-free heating. Freshly made steel has to be rolled, squeezed or otherwise formed into desired shapes from which specific end products such as bars, girders, tubing and strips can be fashioned. When this is done in the usual way, a rust-like scale forms on the hot steel's surface. To prevent the scale from being pressed into the soft metal it has to be scraped off — a costly and time-consuming process.
