Reading Seminar Under Way

Torrance remedial reading teachers, who will conduct special classes for youngsters with reading problems at 14 schools this fall, are attending a series of workshops this summer to study the effect of perceptual difficulties on reading ability.

Specialists in visual perception are teaching the remedial reading teachers how to identify and treat visual perception problems.

In addition, weekly remedial reading demonstrations are being conducted this summer for principals of the 14 schools where reading centers are located. At each session the remedial reading teacher demonstrates a particular teaching technique. Follow-up discussion is conducted by the school principal.

SCHOOLS AT which remedial reading centers will be located during the 1967-68 school years include: Walteria, Wood, Edison, Towers, Calle Mayor, Casimir, Jefferson, Levy, Wright, Crenshaw, Carson, Magruder, Torrance Elementary, and Fern-Greenwood.
