Law Hikes Limits of Insurance

SACRAMENTO—Minimum coverage for automobile liability insurance would be increased under a bill signed into law by Governor Ronald Reagan.

The bill, by Assemblyman Frederick J. Bear, D-San Diego, increases minimum coverage from \$10,000 for injury or death to one person to \$15,000. It also increases uninsured motorist coverage to \$15,000.

Bear said the greater liability coverage and protection would cost motorists an additional 8 to 9 per cent of the liability portion of their automobile insurance premium, depending on where they live.

Syndicate Buys State Water Bond

SACRAMENTO—State Treasurer Ivy Baker Priest has announced the sale of a \$100 million bloc of state water bonds at an average net interest cost of 4.0934 per cent.

The high interest rate bidder was a syndicate headed by the Bank of America, Crocker-Citizens National Bank, United California Bank, and Wells Fargo Bank. The syndicate offered a premium of \$15,500 for the bonds.

Sale of the bonds brought to \$850 million the total water bonds marketed since \$1,750,000,000 was authorized by the voters in 1960.

"In light of today's municipal bond market, both bids were excellent," Mrs. Priest said. "They reflect the confidence of the banking community in California's continued growth and development, and in the state's ability to keep its financial affairs in good order."


