## Regents Act Rules for Admission Revised

The Regents of the University of California have approved revised admission requirements which had been recommended by UC's Board of Admissions and approved by the Assembly of the Academic Senate.

Beginning with the 1968 fall quarter, applicants for admission as freshmen must submit scores from the Scholastic Aptitude Test and three Achievement Tests. The latter must include English composition, one from social studies or foreign language, and one from mathematics or science.

Applicants whose scholarship average in the required high school subjects is 3.00 to 3.09 must achieve a minimum total score of 2,500 on the five examinations. Test results of applicants with grade point averages of 3.1 or higher will be used as guides in counseling and placement.

Acting President Harry R. Wellman told the regents that the revision was desirable because current freshman admission requirements are making 14.6 per cent of all California high school graduates eligible, rather than the 12.5 per cent authorized under the Master Plan.
