Paul R. Lookinland, an administrator with the Los Angeles City Schools, has announced his candidacy for the 68th Assembly District. He currently is serving as the assembly registrar at Dorsey High School.

My educational training and professional experience have led me to make the decision to enter the assembly race," the 33-year-old candidate said.

A native of San Pedro, he was graduated from San Pedro High School in 1952 and from Harbor College in 1954. He received a bachelor's degree in 1956 from Brigham Young University.

Lookinland did graduate from the regional geography while at BYU and received his master's degree in second-year school administration at California State College at Long Beach in 1963.

# New Theater Building Will Rise at College

Los Angeles City Board of Education members have awarded a \$939,000 contract for construction of a new speech-drama building at Los Angeles Harbor College.

Superintendent of Schools Jack P. Crowther said the contract was awarded to Vanlar Construction, Inc., lowest bidder on the project. The work will take 365 days.

Dr. Crowther said the new building is needed to replace inadequate drama facilities which are now housed in a converted area of the college's women's locker room.

The new building will include a 350-seat Little Theater, a 120-seat center stage classroom, a scene shop, dressing rooms, storage area, sanitary facilities, and custodial room.

Two other classrooms and four listening rooms will be included in the speech portion of the one-story building.

Dr. Crowther said the new building is part of a massive junior college construction program planned by the Los Angeles school board to help accommodate a predicted sharp enrollment increase.
