**Bids Filed For Watts Hospital**

Bids have been opened for the county's Southeast General Hospital, designed to serve the health needs of 347,000 citizens in the Watts-Willowbrook and surrounding areas.

An apparent low bid of \$23,540,000 was filed by contractor Robert E. McKee to erect the 400-bed, six-story medical center.

The apparent low bid by the McKee firm was 2 percent below the county engineer's estimated \$24 million cost of the job.

Southeast General Hospital will be built on a 30-acre site at Wilmington Avenue and

**Parks Serve 3 Million Residents in Southwest**

Total, effective use of county parks and recreational facilities has always been a top priority goal of mine. It is pleasing, then, to report that during 1967 more than 3,000,000 persons made use of county parks in my district.

Included in this figure were 443,570 children who participated in organized recreational programs. Thousands of others came to the park "just to play."

For every program in every park there must be a reason based on your wants and your needs.

FOR EXAMPLE, because some youngsters approaching kindergarten are often scared and feel very much alone in the big world of school, we established a "Tiny Tots" program. Mothers and their toddlers meet and the children learn to work and play together.

The sports program for boys is one of the most popular. Teams and leagues are formed in all major sports.

Arts and craft classes are always filled to capacity. They vary from school age youngsters making models to adults working with resins and creating decorative pieces for their homes.

ADULTS MAKE full use of the parks while their children are in school. Everything from sewing and cake decorating classes to volleyball and "slim 'n trim" exercises are offered.

I have been particularly concerned with providing good teenage recreation. These young citizens are growing up fast and they know what they want. With the help of the County Youth Commission and other advisory groups, new exciting teenage programs are being initiated.

All 13 swimming pools in my district will be open soon. (The Sportsman's Park Pool

is open year round.) Will Rogers and Roosevelt Park Pools opened during the Easter vacation and will remain open, weather permitting, afternoons and Saturdays. Starting as soon as school is out, mornings will be devoted to swimming classes for all ages. Afternoons and five evenings a week will be free for recreational swimming.

OUR PARKS program strives to serve all ages. Don't hesitate to let me know if you would like a new program started. If enough requests are received, we'll provide it.




